Breakfast at your hostel will be from 7:00-9:30 every day, while lectures will start at 9:30 in hall F1 at the Faculty from Mon-Thu. On Mon we will gather in front of the hostel at 8:00 exactly. Lunch at Kavarna Mafija, close to the lecture hall (<u>https://goo.gl/maps/ZuYJbRc98LKDMaGT8</u>), will be from 11:45-13:00 Mon-Thu and from 12:45-13:45 on Friday. You will be able to select your lunch dishes from a menu every morning.

Monday, 3th July:

For Monday and Tuesday laboratory tours, you will be split into 3 groups (lead by Humar, Klanjšek, and Koželj) in a lab rotation marked by Lab visit in the timetable. Groups will gather in front of the Faculty to start their tour, which will last until ~16:00. At 16:45 we will again gather in front of the Faculty for a walking tour of Ljubljana, which will end at 18:30 at Pivovarna in Pivnica Kratochwill where we will have dinner [up to 16 € and drinks are on you], which is about a 7-minute walk from your hostel (see attached map https://goo.gl/maps/ebxMjBungW9Czmux5). Tuesday, 4th July:

The Monday–Tuesday lab rotation (marked by Lab visit in the timetable) will finish by ~16:00. After that, you will have the opportunity to meet and chat with current and former international students at the Faculty in the F1 lecture hall. At 18:30, we will meet again for dinner at Pizzeria Foculus [up to 16 € and drinks are on you], a 17-minute walk from your hostel (see attached map <u>https://goo.gl/maps/miL8eLUWcKw47ViY8</u>). Wednesday, 5th July:

The next lab rotation will take place on Wednesday and Thursday and is marked by Lab visit (led by Pestotnik, Kaltenbaek, and Vaskivskyi) in the timetable. The lab visit will last until ~16:00, after which you will be free. At 18:30, we will meet again for dinner, this time at Cantina Mexicana [up to 16 € and drinks are on you], a 10-minute walk from your hostel (attached map https://goo.gl/maps/KJF5c8CX5cstD8QN7). Thursday, 6th July:

The Wednesday–Thursday lab rotation (marked by Lab visit in the timetable) will finish by ~16:00, after which you will be free. At 18:30, we will meet again for dinner, this time at Hombre [up to 16 € and drinks are on you], about a 6-minute walk from the Faculty (see attached map <u>https://goo.gl/maps/juPzjNapoWzUU31U9</u>). As the restaurant is closer to the Faculty than to your hostel, we recommend that you take a shorter walk along the Gradaščica stream or a longer one through the nearby Tivoli park to spend the time until dinner.

Friday, 7th July:

We will **depart from your hostel at 8:15** towards the Reactor Center Podgorica **by bus**. After lectures from 9:00–10:15 there will be **Lab visits** to the nuclear reactor. After these we will return to the Faculty for a lunch break from 12:45 to 13:45 and for the final two lectures, after which you will be free. At 18:30, we will meet again for **dinner, this time at Pivovarna in Pivnica Kratochwill [up to 16 € and drinks are on you]**, about a 7-minute walk from your hostel (see attached map <u>https://goo.gl/maps/ebxMjBungW9Czmux5</u>).

Saturday, 8th July:

We will **depart from your hostel at 7:30** towards Bled **by bus**. At 9:00, we will visit the Bled Vintgar Gorge, which includes an hour and a half of an easy hike. At 11:30, we will arrive at Bled and make a brief stop at Josip Plemelj's villa. At 12:30, we will have lunch at the Murka Restaurant and then visit the Bled Castle at 13:45. After 15:30, you will have a free afternoon with activities like swimming in Lake Bled, visit to the Bled Island (Pletna boat 18€), several sights around Bled (St. Martin church, Belvedere, ...) and others. We will leave Bled at 18:00 from the Bled Bus station, have dinner at the Gala-In restaurants at 18:30, and finally return to Ljubljana at 20:30.
